

OBJECTIONS TO SALVATION ANSWERED

“NOT NOW, SOME OTHER TIME”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

2 Corinthians 6:2; Hebrews 3:15; Proverbs 27:1; Luke 12:19,20

2 Corinthians 6:2

2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.)

Hebrews 3:15

15 While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.

Proverbs 27:1

Boast not thyself of to morrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth.

Luke 12:19-20

19 And I will say to my soul, Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink, *and* be merry. 20 But God said unto him, *Thou* fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?

“I AM TOO GREAT A SINNER”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

Luke 19:10; 1 Timothy 1:15; John 6:37; Hebrews 7:25

Luke 19:10

10 For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

1 Timothy 1:15

15 This *is* a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

John 6:37

37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.

Hebrews 7:25

25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

“I AM DOING THE BEST I CAN”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

Romans 3:19, 20; Romans 3:24; Galatians 2:16

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Romans 3:19-20

19 Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God. 20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law *is* the knowledge of sin.

Romans 3:24

24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

Galatians 2:16

16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

“AFRAID I CAN’T HOLD OUT”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

Jude 24; 2 Timothy 1:12; Hebrews 7:25; John 10:27-29; 1 Peter 1:5; Galatians 2:20

Jude 24

24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present *you* faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

2 Timothy 1:12

12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

Hebrews 7:25

25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

John 10:27-29

27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: 28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any *man* pluck them out of my hand. 29 My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father’s hand.

1 Peter 1:5

5 Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

Galatians 2:20

20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which

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I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

“TOO MANY HYPOCRITES IN CHURCH”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

Matthew 23:10; Romans 14:12; Romans 2:1-3; Colossians 3:25; John 21:22

Matthew 23:10

10 Neither be ye called masters: for one is your Master, *even* Christ.

Romans 14:12

12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

Romans 2:1-3

Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest: for wherein thou judgest another, thou condemnest thyself; for thou that judgest doest the same things. 2 But we are sure that the judgment of God is according to truth against them which commit such things. 3 And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God?

Colossians 3:25

25 But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath done: and there is no respect of persons.

John 21:22

22 Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what *is that* to thee? follow thou me.

“I AM A CHURCH MEMBER”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

John 3:3; Galatians 2:16; Ephesians 2:8-9; 2 Timothy 1:9; Titus 1:16; Matthew 7:21-23

John 3:3

3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

Galatians 2:16

16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

Ephesians 2:8-9

8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: 9 Not of

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works, lest any man should boast.

2 Timothy 1:9

9 Who hath saved us, and called *us* with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

Titus 1:16

16 They profess that they know God; but in works they deny *him*, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

Matthew 7:21-23

21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. 22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

“COMMITTED UNPARDONABLE SIN”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

John 6:37; Romans 10:13; 2 Peter 3:9; John 6:40, 47

John 6:37

37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.

Romans 10:13

13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

2 Peter 3:9

9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

John 6:40,47

40 And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day. 47 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.

“BELIEVE I AM GOOD ENOUGH”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

Isaiah 64:6; John 3:3-5; John 3:18; John 8:24; Romans 6:23; Romans 3:22, 23

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Isaiah 64:6

6 But we are all as an unclean *thing*, and all our righteousnesses *are* as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

John 3:3-5

3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. 4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? 5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and *of* the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

John 3:18

18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

John 8:24

24 I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am *he*, ye shall die in your sins.

Romans 6:23

23 For the wages of sin *is* death; but the gift of God *is* eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 3:22-23

22 Even the righteousness of God *which is* by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: 23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

“GOD WILL NOT CONDEMN ANYONE”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

Luke 13:3; John 3:36; Romans 2:4,5; 2 Peter 2:4,6, 9; John 3:18

Luke 13:3

3 I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.

John 3:36

36 He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

Romans 2:4-5

4 Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance? 5 But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment

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of God;

2 Peter 2:4,6,9

4 For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast *them* down to hell, and delivered *them* into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment; 6 And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrha into ashes condemned *them* with an overthrow, making *them* an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly; 9 The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished:

John 3:18

18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

“CANNOT FORGIVE OTHERS”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

Mark 11:25, 26; Matthew 6:15; 1 John 4:20; Philippians 4:13

Mark 11:25-26

25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. 26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

Matthew 6:15

15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

1 John 4:20

20 If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?

Philippians 4:13

13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

“ANOTHER CHANCE AFTER DEATH”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

Hebrews 9:27; Hebrews 2:3; Revelation 20:11-15

Hebrews 9:27

27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

Hebrews 2:3

3 How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the

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Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard *him*;

Revelation 20:11-15

11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. 12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book of life*: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. 14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

“BELIEVE EVERYBODY WILL BE SAVED”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

Mark 16:16; Matthew 25:41, 46; John 5:28-29 ; Acts 24:15; Daniel 12:2; 1 Corinthians 6:9, 10; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9

Mark 16:16

16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Matthew 25:41

41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

John 5:28-29

28 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, 29 And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

Acts 24:15

15 And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.

Daniel 12:2

2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame *and* everlasting contempt.

1 Corinthians 6:9-10

9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom

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of God.

2 Thessalonians 1:7-9

7 And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, 8 In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: 9 Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;

“CANNOT PAY THE PRICE”: THE BIBLE ANSWER IS:

Mark 8:36; James 4:4; 1 John 2:15-17; Romans 12:2; 2 Corinthians 6:17; 1 Corinthians 10:21

Mark 8:36

36 For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?

James 4:4

4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

1 John 2:15-17

15 Love not the world, neither the things *that are* in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16 For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. 17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

Romans 12:2

2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

2 Corinthians 6:17

17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean *thing*; and I will receive you,

1 Corinthians 10:21

21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.
