INTRODUCTION

At the outset, I want to state that there never has been a more perilous time in American history. America as a nation is spiritually blind and in bondage to the Devil. We have rejected the God of the Bible for a God of our own choosing. Because we have rejected God, God has sent us strong delusion that we would believe the lies of our ungodly and unsaved political, judicial, and religious leaders. We are living in a time when America's God hating political and religious leaders have become evil men and seducers that are deceiving and being deceived. There seems to be no end to the wickedness that pervades the land. It waxes worse and worse everyday. As a nation, we lie down in our shame, and our confusion covereth us: for we have sinned against the LORD our God, we and our fathers, from our youth even unto this day, and have not obeyed the voice of the LORD our God. What should be rolling forth from our hearts and our lips is the prayer of Daniel the prophet where he says in Daniel 9:5-10:

⁵ We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts and from thy judgments: ⁶Neither have we hearkened unto thy servants the prophets, which spake in thy name to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land. ⁷O Lord, righteousness *belongeth* unto thee, but unto us confusion of faces, as at this day; to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and unto all Israel, *that are* near, and *that are* far off, through all the countries whither thou hast driven them, because of their trespass that they have trespassed against thee. ⁸O Lord, to us *belongeth* confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against thee. ⁹To the Lord our God *belong* mercies and forgivenesses, though we have rebelled against him; ¹⁰ Neither have we obeyed the voice of the LORD our God, to walk in his laws, which he set before us by his servants the prophets.

We have let the strength of this world become our shame and our confusion. Our political leaders are proclaiming peace and safety when all the while their wicked and ungodly actions are bringing sudden destruction upon us. We are living in a time when our entire national political discourse has become the perverse disputings of men and women of corrupt and reprobate minds. It is a discourse that is destitute of any of the truth of the Word of God. Our judicial system is corrupt to its wicked and ungodly core. The guiding light of our judicial system is the darkness of Satan. The power behind our judicial system is the heartbeat of Satan. Our unsaved and ungodly religious leaders are teaching and preaching doctrines of devils and damnable heresies that are turning lost sinners into flaming fodder to feed the fires of hell. Hell hath much enlarged herself with the sizzling bodies of lost sinners that have been deceived by Satan's sinister ministers into thinking they are saved when all they have done is repeated a sinner's prayer that has made them twofold more a child of hell than the devil that deceived them. A salvation that shows forth no repentance is a salvation that inhabits the fiery pits of hell and the lake of fire. You cannot get saved and continue to do the Devil's bidding. You cannot claim salvation and continue to act like the Devil himself.

As a country, we cannot continue to do the bidding of the Devil and then expect God to continue to bless America. It is the Devil's bidding when 47% of Americans are on some form of welfare and most of them will not work. The Bible says that a man who will not work should not eat. It is the Devil's bidding when we call murder pro-choice. We have murdered 56,000,000 babies since the pro baby murdering Supreme Court legalized abortion in 1973. God is not pro-choice. God calls abortion the shedding of innocent blood and an abomination. The only thing that is pro-choice in the matter is that it is your choice to murder an innocent baby. The baby has no choice. It is the Devil's bidding to call sodomy an alternate life style and a constitutional right. God calls sodomy an abomination that leads to a reprobate mind that ends up in hell. The Bible calls lesbians, homosexuals, and child molesters sodomites. It is unnatural, wicked, destructive, and ungodly for men to have sex with men, for women to have sex with women, and for adults to have sex with children. You are not born into sodomy. Sodomy is not a psychological or psychiatric problem. Sodomy is a sin that is the product of a perverse and reprobate mind whose desires are driven by Satan. All sodomites are unsaved devils. It is the Devil's bidding when we have a national epidemic of drug abuse that we call therapy when God calls it sorcery. It is the Devil's bidding when we take prayer out of our schools when God says that we ought to always pray (pray without ceasing). When you live in a nation where a national political party has to argue about whether to include references to God, Israel, and Jerusalem in their official party platform you are in serious trouble. When you have a president that is in favor of murdering babies through abortion, that is in favor of sodomite marriages, that is pro Muslim, that is anti Jewish, that is anti Israel, that is pro socialist and humanist, that is pro communist, and that is anti Christian then you have a Godless reprobate in the White House. In the upcoming presidential election, if you vote for Barak Hussein Obama you are voting to put a devil back in the White House that is possessed of the spirit of antichrist. It is high time Christians and Americans awoke out of their sleep. The problem in the Middle East is not about geography stupid. It is not about justice for a non-existent Palestinian people. It is time for Republicans, Democrats, and American Christian leaders to stop supporting these Muslim devils. Psalm 119 verses104 and 128 say:

- ¹⁰⁴ Through thy precepts I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way.
- ¹²⁸ Therefore I esteem all *thy* precepts *concerning* all *things to be* right; *and* I hate every false way.

Our battle cry to our political and religious leaders should be that of Jehu in 2 Chronicles 19:2 where he said: "Shouldest thou help the ungodly, and love them that hate the LORD? therefore *is* wrath upon thee from before the LORD." I can hear the Devil screaming religious discrimination already (Unless, of course, it is genuine discrimination against Jews and Christians). Islam is not a purely religious organization. You cannot grant freedom to an organization whose stated objective is to overthrow your government and take away every religious freedom you have. Islam is much more a political religious system than anything else. The Muslims should be treated no different than the Communists were treated when they were trying to overthrow the United States government. In fact, the Muslims are much more dangerous than the Communists ever thought about being. Would you give a child molester the freedom to play with your children?? The United States should outlaw Shariah law and prosecute anyone who attempts to enforce its provisions for subversion and sedition against the people of the United States of America. Not only has Obama invited the Muslim Brotherhood into the White House, but he has done everything he could to distance and alienate himself from the nation of Israel and Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. Obama has snubbed no other leader like he has snubbed Benjamin Netanyahu. What Obama done to Benjamin Netanyahu was an insult to the dignity of the office of the presidency of the United States. Obama has made it plain that he will do anything to Israel to gain favor with his Muslim brothers. Frank Gaffney served as the Assistant Secretary of Defense for International Security Policy under President Ronald Reagan. The sixteen key findings of Mr. Gaffney concerning the Muslim Brotherhood in America are as follows:

- 1. Shariah is a totalitarian, brutally repressive and supremacist doctrine. Its adherents notably, the Muslim Brotherhood seek to bring it here.
- 2. Shariah is principally about power, not faith. Accordingly, acting to realize its political end of overthrowing the U.S. government is seditious and must be prosecuted, not treated as protected religious practice.
- 3. The Brotherhood is not a non-violent group. Rather, in most countries where it operates including the United States, it is in a pre-violent phase.
- 4. The Muslim Brotherhood's strategic plan, the group's mission in America is a "civilization-jihadist process…a kind of grand jihad in eliminating and destroying Western civilization from within" by our hands.
- 5. The Muslim Brotherhood's civilization jihad is being pursued through stealthy means involving the penetration and subversion of this country's civil society and governing institutions. Presidencies of both parties have been compromised in this way.
- 6. One determinant of the success of such a stealthy, pre-violent jihad is what the military calls "information dominance." If the Muslim Brotherhood can exercise it, we can be kept ignorant of the true nature of the threat they pose

- and the progress they are making in bringing shariah to America. That has been substantially the case over the past ten years and increasingly of late.
- 7. The Muslim Brotherhood was helped in its efforts to achieve information dominance over the George W. Bush administration, thanks to collaboration between a top Muslim Brotherhood operative, Abdurahman Alamoudi, and anti-tax activist Grover Norquist.
- 8. In addition to al Qaeda financier Alamoudi, Norquist helped mainstream in the Bush campaign and/or administration five other Muslims with extensive ties to the Muslim Brotherhood. They were: the Islamic Free Market Institute's Khalid Saffuri, CAIR's Nihad Awad, Palestinian Jihad's Sami al-Arian, the Fiqh Council's Muzzamil Siddiqi and Suhail Khan, a former staffer for Rep. Tom Campbell of California.
- 9. In his capacity as the de facto Muslim gatekeeper in the Office of Public Liaison under senior Bush advisor Karl Rove, and then as an assistant in the personal office of the Secretary of Transportation, Khan had, at a minimum, an opportunity to facilitate the penetration of other Islamists.
- 10. Both during and after the Bush administration, Norquist has used various organizations to promote Islamist agendas. These have included Red-Green coalitions made up of radical and other leftists and Muslim Brotherhood front groups with whom they routinely make common cause, to the detriment of U.S. security, constitutional freedoms and other interests.
- 11. Norquist has worked for years to "create relations with top political leaders and Muslims." Of late, that has included running such Muslims for elective office as Republicans. Three of his protégés Kamal Nawash, Faisal Gill and Imad "David" Ramadan have met with mixed results in their runs for state legislative seats in Virginia thanks to troubling questions about their backgrounds and associations.
- 12. Norquist continues to support Islamist agenda items and to work to counter initiatives opposed by the Brothers. In the process, he has collaborated with radical leftists and Islamists in Red-Green Coalitions, the latter include Iranian influence operations.
- 13. The precedents, personnel and policies promoted by Norquist and his friends during the George W. Bush administration have metastasized dramatically under that of President Obama.

- 14. Notably, six Islamist-sympathizers have achieved positions within or advisory roles serving Team Obama: Special Envoy to the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Rashad Hussein; Deputy Chief of Staff to Secretary of State Hillary Clinton Huma Abedein; Presidential advisor Dalia Mogahed; FBI Citizens Academy graduate Kifah Mustafa; Homeland Security Advisory Committee Member Mohamed Elibiary and Homeland Security Countering Violent Extremism Working Group Member Mohamed Magid.
- 15. The conduct of seven key federal agencies suggests the considerable success of the Muslim Brotherhood in destroying us from within by our own hands starting with the policies and directives emanating from the Oval Office and elsewhere in the White House complex, and including the priorities and activities of: the Office of the Director of National Intelligence, the Departments of State, Justice, Defense and Homeland Security and even NASA.
- 16. There are myriad steps Americans can and must take to counter this civilization jihad. Some can be undertaken as individuals; some through organized efforts; and others as a nation.

Frank Gaffney concluded his comments with the following statement:

In light of these findings, there is an urgent need for rigorous congressional oversight and investigations aimed at exposing the extent of the civilization jihad – and the need for corrective action aimed at countering it, particularly by federal authorities. Such legislative branch initiatives should be accompanied by corresponding actions initiated by Inspectors General and, as appropriate, law enforcement.

Now, is their a real danger to America and Israel from these warmongering Muslims? America's fear of these warmongering Muslim devils has led us to every form of compromise and hypocrisy when dealing with them.

It is the height of hypocrisy when America or any other nation will condemn Israel when she responds to the Islamic terrorist attacks against their country and against their people. It is the height of hypocrisy when America will tell Israel they cannot construct a fence to protect themselves against the Islamic terrorists when America has constructed a fence along her border with Mexico. It is the height of hypocrisy when America condemns Israel for responding to Islamic acts of war such as firing missiles, rockets, and artillery shells into Israeli cities. Now, I want to deal with the issue of where Israel stands in relation to what God teaches us in His Word. Turn in your Bibles to:

Genesis 12:1-3

¹ Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: ² And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: ³ And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Joel 3:2

² I will also gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them there for my people and *for* my heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations, and parted my land.

Romans 11:1-2

¹ I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, *of* the tribe of Benjamin. ²God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying,

Romans 11:26-27

²⁶ And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: ²⁷ For this *is* my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.

Zechariah 8:22-23 ²² Yea, many people and strong nations shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before the LORD. ²³ Thus saith the LORD of hosts; In those days *it shall come to pass*, that ten men shall take hold out of all languages of the nations, even shall take hold of the skirt of him that is a Jew, saying, We will go with you: for we have heard *that* God *is* with you.

1 Chronicles 16:7-36 (KJV)⁷ Then on that day David delivered first *this psalm* to thank the LORD into the hand of Asaph and his brethren. ⁸ Give thanks unto the LORD, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people. ⁹ Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, talk ye of all his wondrous works. ¹⁰ Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD. ¹¹ Seek the LORD and his strength, seek his face continually. ¹² Remember his marvellous works that he hath done, his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth; ¹³ O ye seed of Israel his servant, ye children of Jacob, his chosen ones. ¹⁴ He *is* the LORD our God; his judgments *are* in all the earth. ¹⁵ Be ye mindful always of his covenant; the word *which* he commanded to a thousand generations; ¹⁶ Even of the covenant which he made with Abraham, and of his oath unto Isaac; ¹⁷ And hath confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting covenant, ¹⁸ Saying, Unto thee will I give the land of Canaan, the lot of your inheritance; ¹⁹ When ye were but few, even a few, and

strangers in it. ²⁰ And when they went from nation to nation, and from one kingdom to another people; ²¹ He suffered no man to do them wrong: yea, he reproved kings for their sakes, ²² Saying, Touch not mine anointed, and do my prophets no harm. ²³ Sing unto the LORD, all the earth; shew forth from day to day his salvation. ²⁴ Declare his glory among the heathen; his marvellous works among all nations. ²⁵ For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised: he also is to be feared above all gods. ²⁶ For all the gods of the people *are* idols: but the LORD made the heavens. ²⁷ Glory and honour *are* in his presence; strength and gladness *are* in his place. ²⁸ Give unto the LORD, ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength. ²⁹ Give unto the LORD the glory *due* unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness. ³⁰ Fear before him, all the earth: the world also shall be stable, that it be not moved. ³¹Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice: and let men say among the nations, The LORD reigneth. ³² Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof: let the fields rejoice, and all that is therein. ³³Then shall the trees of the wood sing out at the presence of the LORD, because he cometh to judge the earth. 34 O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever. 35 And say ye, Save us, O God of our salvation, and gather us together, and deliver us from the heathen, that we may give thanks to thy holy name, and glory in thy praise. ³⁶ Blessed be the LORD God of Israel for ever and ever. And all the people said, Amen, and praised the LORD.

No let us turn to Psalm 105 and read verses 16 through 45:

Psalm 105:16-45 (KJV)¹⁶ Moreover he called for a famine upon the land: he brake the whole staff of bread. ¹⁷He sent a man before them, even Joseph, who was sold for a servant: ¹⁸ Whose feet they hurt with fetters: he was laid in iron: ¹⁹ Until the time that his word came: the word of the LORD tried him. ²⁰ The king sent and loosed him; even the ruler of the people, and let him go free. ²¹ He made him lord of his house, and ruler of all his substance: ²² To bind his princes at his pleasure; and teach his senators wisdom. ²³ Israel also came into Egypt; and Jacob sojourned in the land of Ham. ²⁴ And he increased his people greatly; and made them stronger than their enemies. ²⁵ He turned their heart to hate his people, to deal subtilly with his servants. ²⁶ He sent Moses his servant; *and* Aaron whom he had chosen. ²⁷ They shewed his signs among them, and wonders in the land of Ham. ²⁸ He sent darkness, and made it dark; and they rebelled not against his word. ²⁹ He turned their waters into blood, and slew their fish. ³⁰ Their land brought forth frogs in abundance, in the chambers of their kings. ³¹ He spake, and there came divers sorts of flies, *and* lice in all their coasts. ³² He gave them hail for rain, and flaming fire in their land. ³³ He smote their vines also and their fig trees; and brake the trees of their coasts. ³⁴ He spake, and the locusts came, and caterpillers, and that without number, 35 And did eat up all the herbs in their land, and devoured the fruit of their ground. ³⁶ He smote also all the

firstborn in their land, the chief of all their strength. ³⁷ He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and *there was* not one feeble *person* among their tribes. ³⁸ Egypt was glad when they departed: for the fear of them fell upon them. ³⁹ He spread a cloud for a covering; and fire to give light in the night. ⁴⁰ *The people* asked, and he brought quails, and satisfied them with the bread of heaven. ⁴¹ He opened the rock, and the waters gushed out; they ran in the dry places *like* a river. ⁴² For he remembered his holy promise, *and* Abraham his servant. ⁴³ And he brought forth his people with joy, *and* his chosen with gladness: ⁴⁴ And gave them the lands of the heathen: and they inherited the labour of the people; ⁴⁵ That they might observe his statutes, and keep his laws. Praise ye the LORD.

Verses 8 through 22 of 1 Chronicles 16 are repeated in Psalm 105 verses 1 through 15. Psalm 105 verses 16 through 45 deal with the judgments brought upon Pharaoh and Egypt because they had chosen to touch God's anointed. God's anointed is the nation of Israel and the Jewish people. The phrase "touch not mine anointed" in 1 Chronicles 16:22 and Psalm 105:15 is a reference to the people themselves and not to a Baptist preacher that acts like a pope. I have heard preachers apply that phrase exclusively to themselves and pastors many times. That is a misinterpretation and misapplication of the scriptures. In context, the phrase "touch not mine anointed" is clearly talking about the people. These 30 verses in Psalm 105 are a broad overview of the judgments brought upon Egypt through the plagues in Exodus chapters 7 through 12.

Zechariah 8:22-23 ²² Yea, many people and strong nations shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before the LORD. ²³ Thus saith the LORD of hosts; In those days *it shall come to pass*, that ten men shall take hold out of all languages of the nations, even shall take hold of the skirt of him that is a Jew, saying, We will go with you: for we have heard *that* God *is* with you.

The purpose of this entire sermon series is to Biblically defend the Jew and the nation of Israel. If you claim to be a Christian and you have a problem with the Jew and with Israel, then you have a problem with the Lord Jesus Christ. The name Jesus literally means "JEHOVAH saves". The Lord Jesus Christ was a Biblically perfect Jew. The Lord Jesus Christ is God come in a Jew's flesh. He is the eternal, the perfect, the preeminent, the sinless Jew. Not only was he sinless: he could NOT have sinned because he was very GOD manifested in the flesh. The Lord Jesus Christ was tempted in all points just as you are not because he could sin, but so that he could prove to you and I that he could not sin. I repeat. The Lord Jesus Christ is God come in a Jew's flesh. He is the eternal God Man. When the Son of God descended into flesh made of a woman, he was never the same again. He became the eternal crucified God Man in Jewish flesh. If you have a problem with the Jew, then you have a problem with the great I AM THAT I AM of Exodus chapter 3. The gift of the land of Canaan was given in the name of JEHOVAH and not the wicked and perverted name of Yahweh. Yahweh is an expression of the wickedness of modern, unbelieving Bible correctors and perverters. Yahweh is Satan's perversion of God's name Jehovah. By the way, if you don't have a King James Bible, then you do not have a perfect English Bible. What you have is a perverted English book.

Jehovah God says 203 times that he is the God of Israel. He never says that he is the God of the Americans, the God of the Arabs, the God of Iranians, or of any of their nations. God never refers to Himself as the God of Ishmael. The little "g" god of the Ishmaelites is Satan himself and the Devil's prophet is Mohammad. God never refers to the Promised Land as Palestine. The Hebrew word from which Palestine is translated occurs eight times in the Old Testament and is never used in relation to God's blessings upon the land or His people. The land of "Palestine" and its peoples are used as an instrument of God's wrath, judgment, and destruction. In its last use in the Old Testament in Joel 3:4, it is in the place of the events that lead up to an include Armageddon. Palestine is not a place of blessing and the fulfillment of God's promises to His people. Palestine is a place of cursing and utter destruction of all nations that hate God, that hate the Jew, that hate the Christian, and that hate the nation of Israel. The Philistines are ancient enemies of God's people.

Any attempt to transfer the promises given to the nation of Israel to the Church is rooted in anti-Semitism. When the church tries to take for herself the blessings given to the nation of Israel they are guilty of putting themselves in the role of Ishmael. THE CHURCH IS NOT ISRAEL. THE COVENANTS AND BLESSINGS PROMISED TO ISRAEL IN THE OLD TESTAMENT STILL BELONG TO ISRAEL. GOD STILL HAS A PLAN FOR THE NATION OF ISRAEL THAT DOES NOT INCLUDE THE CHURCH. The relationship that God has with Israel is an EVERLASTING covenant relationship that is wrapped up in the Abrahamic Covenant. The Abrahamic Covenant contains everlasting, unconditional promises that were made to Abraham concerning his seed line through Isaac . These promises included a seed, a land, and a throne. The covenant concerning the land is wrongfully referred to by many Baptists as the Palestinian Covenant when it should be called the Canaan Covenant (or the Promised Land Covenant). This statement is discussed in greater detail below. The covenant concerning the throne is properly called the Davidic Covenant because it is rooted in a promise that God gave to King David.

Many of the Reformation leaders such as Martin Luther and John Calvin hated Jews. The Reformers and their Roman Catholic mother were guilty of genocide because it was their habit to persecute and murder Jews and Bible believing Christians. Adolph Hitler and his SS first learned their hatred and persecution of the Jews from the Roman Catholic Church. The German government's idea of tagging the Jews with yellow badges came straight out of fourteenth century Roman Catholicism. Because the Reformers and the Roman Catholic Church hated the Jews, their theology was tailor made to justify the persecution and murder of the Jews and to usurp the blessings and promises that God has given to his chosen people (the Jews). Though this pagan, worldly church is willing to usurp and claim the blessings given to Israel, they are unwilling to claim the curses that come from their disobedience. Many of these folks will tell you that the Jews are deserving of persecution and hatred because they rejected the Lord Jesus Christ and were responsible for his crucifixion. If Israel was deserving of persecution and murder because they rejected the Lord Jesus Christ, then much more so the pagan, apostate professing church of today that has rejected the Lord Jesus Christ for Satan and doctrines of devils. Any doctrine or sentiment that takes away from the necessity of the

crucifixion is Satanic! The Lord Jesus Christ himself said so in Matthew 16:21-23 and Mark 8:31-33:

Matthew 16:21-23

²¹ From that time forth began Jesus to shew unto his disciples, how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day. ²² Then Peter took him, and began to rebuke him, saying, Be it far from thee, Lord: this shall not be unto thee. ²³ But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

And also in:

Mark 8:31-33³¹ And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and *of* the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again. ³² And he spake that saying openly. And Peter took him, and began to rebuke him. ³³ But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.

Therefore any doctrine that exclusively blames the Jews for the crucifixion of the Lord Jesus Christ is not scriptural. The fact is, every person who has ever lived is responsible for the crucifixion of the Lord Jesus Christ. It was our sins and not those of the Jews only that put him on the cross. Jesus was killed because of the sins of Jews and Gentiles.

I repeat, if Israel was deserving of persecution and murder because they rejected the Lord Jesus Christ, then much more so the pagan, apostate professing church of today that has rejected the Lord Jesus Christ for Satan and the doctrines of devils. We make that statement in a tongue and cheek fashion. We are not advocating violence against unbelievers, apostates, and heretics. It is unscriptural to take up carnal weapons in defense of the faith. 2 Corinthians 10:3-4 says: ³ For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: ⁴ (For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;). Any violence carried out against Jews and Bible believing Christians by the Roman harlot and her harlot daughters is wicked sin and will be avenged by God himself. How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth (Revelation 6:10)? The violence perpetrated against Jews and Bible believing Christians by the Roman Catholic Church, Martin Luther and his followers, John Calvin and his followers, Ulrich Zwingli and his followers, the Anglican Church in England and America, and any other persecutor in any land is worse than the Islamic terror of

today because so-called "Christians" ought to know better. God is also going to avenge the persecution, torture, and murder of Christians and Jews at the hands of Muslims.

REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY

Any church or denomination that takes upon itself the role of persecuting or setting aside Israel is guilty of being of the synagogue of Satan and is a part of the bride of the Antichrist (Revelation 17). The heresy that says the promises given to Israel have been forfeited to the Church is called Replacement Theology. Replacement Theology is theologically systemized anti-Semitism. This doctrine is unscriptural and plays into the hands of Islamic terrorists. Yet, this doctrine has been latched onto by the Roman Catholics and practically all her Protestant harlots including Methodists, Presbyterians, Anglicans, Lutherans, Episcopalians, Reformed Churches, and etc. This doctrine has resulted in the almost constant condemnation of Israel by these apostate denominations and the defending of acts of terror and destruction by those hate mongering, child murdering, women murdering, Palestinian Islamic terrorists. They need to repent and trust the Lord Jesus Christ as their Saviour. If they do not repent, they are going to march straight into hell behind Mohammad.

Any advocate of Replacement theology is a tool of Satan. Any teaching that takes the promises that were given to Israel and gives them to the church is heresy. Paul plainly states in Romans 11:1-2, 26-27:

¹ I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, *of* the tribe of Benjamin. ²God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying, ²⁶ And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: ²⁷ For this *is* my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.

How plain can the scriptures be? Verse 2 says that God has not cast away Israel. Verse 27 says that God still has a covenant with Israel. God used the word "Israel" 2,576 times in the Scriptures. Consider this. God used the word Israel 75 times in the New Testament. God also used the words "church" or "churches" 117 times in the New Testament. Did God forget what the meaning of Israel was in the New Testament?? Could not God say Israel when he meant Israel and "the church" when he meant "the church"?? Did God get confused somewhere between the Old Testament and the New Testament?? The problem is that when the words of Scripture do not line up with their theology and prejudices, Replacement theologians start spiritualizing the Scriptures instead of interpreting them literally. When we start taking away from and adding to the Scriptures we are definitely giving a strong indication of where we are in our relationship with God.

The most violent exercise of Replacement Theology (anti Semitism) has been by the Roman Catholic Church. It was from the crypts of Roman Catholic theology that Replacement Theology came slithering forth. It was in the whited sepulchers of Roman Catholicism that the devils of Hitler's Third Reich were nurtured and fed from Satan's table. Adolph Hitler and his Nazi henchman were practicing Roman Catholic Replacement Theology when they murdered millions of Jews. The Roman Catholic Church has the chutzpah (shameless audacity) to take upon itself the position of the woman in Revelation 12. Anyone with any knowledge of the scriptures and that has not been blinded by hatred for Israel knows that the woman of Revelation 12 is the nation of Israel. That it is clearly a reference to the nation of Israel is obvious from Genesis 37:9-11 which says:

⁹ And he dreamed yet another dream, and told it his brethren, and said, Behold, I have dreamed a dream more; and, behold, the sun and the moon and the eleven stars made obeisance to me. ¹⁰ And he told *it* to his father, and to his brethren: and his father rebuked him, and said unto him, What *is* this dream that thou hast dreamed? Shall I and thy mother and thy brethren indeed come to bow down ourselves to thee to the earth? ¹¹ And his brethren envied him; but his father observed the saying.

Now compare that to Revelation 12:1-2, 13:

¹ And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars: ² And she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered. ¹³ And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man *child*.

The Roman Catholic Church has never suffered the wrath of Satan. The Roman Catholic harlot is the bride of Satan. The great wrath that Satan has is for the nation and people of Israel. That wrath will continue until the end. Revelation 12:12-15 says:

¹² Therefore rejoice, *ye* heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time. ¹³ And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man *child*. ¹⁴ And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent. ¹⁵ And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood.

The Roman Catholic Church did not bring forth the man child. The man child was the Lord Jesus Christ who was brought forth by Mary, a daughter of Israel. The viper of persecution came slithering forth from the sewer of anti-Semitic Roman Catholic theology. The Roman Catholic Church has been the preeminent poisonous fountainhead of religious persecution and hatred of Jews and Bible believing Christians. Roman Catholic and so-called Protestant Replacement Theology and other doctrines of devils are laced with spiritual cyanide and strychnine that has brought forth physical death for those she persecutes and spiritual death for those who are deceived by her doctrine of devils. Islam runs a very close second in the destruction of Jews and Bible believing Christians. Roman Catholicism has been the Trojan Horse in the house of apostate Christianity which is deceiving and being deceived.

GOD'S COVENANTS WITH ISRAEL

God's relationship with Israel is based upon His unconditional unilateral, everlasting covenant with Abraham and his seed. This covenant is referred to many times as the Abrahamic Covenant. The Abrahamic Covenant is composed of four different covenants. These covenants are unconditional in the sense that they require no action by Israel for their enforcement and eventual fulfillment. In other words, the covenants remain in effect forever regardless of Israel's disobedience. However, the participation in the blessings of the covenants is conditioned on Israel's obedience to the Mosaic Covenant.

The Abrahamic Covenant is said to be a fourfold covenant in that it involves a seed, a land, a throne, and the heart. Most of the time these covenants are treated as separate covenants apart from the Abrahamic Covenant. The Seed Covenant involves both an earthly and a spiritual seed. The Land Covenant involves the Promised Land, or Canaan Land. The Throne Covenant involves the throne of David and is generally referred to as the Davidic Covenant. The Heart Covenant is generally called the New Covenant.

The Abrahamic Covenant is first stated in general terms in Genesis 12:1-7. This Scripture reads:

Genesis 12:1-7

¹ Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: ² And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: ³ And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed. ⁴ So Abram departed, as the

LORD had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him: and Abram *was* seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran. ⁵ And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their substance that they had gathered, and the souls that they had gotten in Haran; and they went forth to go into the land of Canaan; and into the land of Canaan they came. ⁶ And Abram passed through the land unto the place of Sichem, unto the plain of Moreh. And the Canaanite *was* then in the land. ⁷ And the LORD appeared unto Abram, and said, Unto thy seed will I give this land: and there builded he an altar unto the LORD, who appeared unto him.

In verse 2, we can see a sixfold promise given to Abram (Abraham). The first promise is that he would make of Abram a great nation. This is a threefold promise in that a great nation must be composed of a great people, a great land, and a great leader (King).

The fourth promise was that God would bless Abram. From the Scriptures, we know that Abram became a very rich man in goods.

The fifth promise to Abraham was that his name would be great. Abraham's name indeed became great. He is claimed as one of the great names in the Bible. His name is called out 250 times in 230 verses in the Bible. Abraham is wrongfully hailed as one of the fathers of Islam. His name is mentioned 76 times in the Koran and 162 times in the Hadith. The Koran is the wicked and unholy babblings of Satan through the devil possessed Islamic wizard, Mohammad. The Hadith is the so-called sayings of that devil possessed, child molesting, false prophet Mohammad. So Abraham's name is revered in paganism (Islam and Roman Catholicism), in Judaism, and in Bible believing Christianity.

In the sixth promise from verse 2, God told Abraham that not only would he be blessed, but that Abraham would be a blessing. Abraham is told in verse 3 that his blessing would be extended to all families of the earth. This blessing is linked to the Abrahamic Covenant and is generally referred to as the Seed Covenant. This blessing was both an earthly blessing and a spiritual blessing that was given to Abraham. It promised him a physical seed in the children of Israel and a spiritual seed in both the Jew and the Gentile. The blessings of the Seed Covenant were made available through the Lord Jesus Christ. This blessing is discussed in much detail in Romans 4:1-22 and in Galatians 3:6-29. This Seed Covenant was restated to Abraham in Genesis 18:18 and Genesis 22:18. The Seed Covenant was restated to Isaac in Genesis 26:4 and to Jacob in Genesis 28:14. Each and every covenant that is part of the Abrahamic Covenant is declared to be an everlasting covenant by God. That this was a continuing and everlasting covenant is plain from the New Testament in Romans 9-11 and Galatians 3:8-17.

Matthew 25:31-46 is a restatement by the Lord Jesus Christ of the blessings and curses tied to the Abrahamic Covenant given to Abram (Abraham) in Genesis 12:1-7.

God fills in the details of the Abrahamic Covenant in Genesis 13:15, Genesis 15:18, and in Genesis 17. Genesis 13:15 says: "15 For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever". Genesis 15:18 says: "In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates". Genesis 17:1-19 says:

Genesis 17:1-19

And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect. ² And I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly. ³ And Abram fell on his face: and God talked with him, saying, ⁴ As for me, behold, my covenant is with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations. ⁵ Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee. ⁶ And I will make thee exceeding fruitful, and I will make nations of thee, and kings shall come out of thee. ⁷ And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee. 8 And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their God. ⁹ And God said unto Abraham, Thou shalt keep my covenant therefore, thou, and thy seed after thee in their generations. ¹⁰ This is my covenant, which ye shall keep, between me and you and thy seed after thee; Every man child among you shall be circumcised. 11 And ye shall circumcise the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of the covenant betwixt me and you. ¹² And he that is eight days old shall be circumcised among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which is not of thy seed. 13 He that is born in thy house, and he that is bought with thy money, must needs be circumcised: and my covenant shall be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant. 14 And the uncircumcised man child whose flesh of his foreskin is not circumcised, that soul shall be cut off from his people; he hath broken my covenant. ¹⁵ And God said unto Abraham, As for Sarai thy wife, thou shalt not call her name Sarai, but Sarah shall her name be. 16 And I will bless her, and give thee a son also of her: yea, I will bless her, and she shall be a mother of nations; kings of people shall be of her. ¹⁷ Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart, Shall a child be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear? ¹⁸ And Abraham said unto God, O that Ishmael might live before thee! ¹⁹ And God said, Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a son indeed; and thou shalt call his name Isaac: and I will establish

my covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him.

The promises given to Abraham in this covenant include:

- 1. God would make Abraham a great nation. Genesis 12:2
- 2. God would make Abraham's name great. Genesis 12:2
- 3. God would bless Abraham. Genesis 12:2
- **4.** God would make Abraham a blessing. Genesis 12:2
- **5.** God would bless those that blessed Abraham. Genesis 12:3
- **6.** God would curse those that cursed Abraham. Genesis 12:3
- **7.** God said that all the families of the earth would be blessed in Abraham. Genesis 12:3
- **8.** God would give the land of Canaan to Abraham and his seed for ever. Genesis 13:15
- **9.** God made a covenant with Abraham and his seed to give him the land of Canaan. Genesis 15:18
- 10. God would multiply Abraham exceedingly. Genesis 17:2
- 11. Abraham would be the father of many nations. Genesis 17:4
- 12. Abraham would be exceeding fruitful. Genesis 17:6
- **13.** Abraham would have kings come out of him. Genesis 17:6
- **14.** The covenant between God, Abraham, and his seed is an <u>everlasting covenant</u>. Genesis 17:7
- **15.** God promised the land of Canaan for an **everlasting possession**. Genesis 17:8
- **16.** The token of the covenant is circumcision. Genesis 17:11-14
- 17. God stated that the covenant promise was with Isaac and NOT with Ishmael. Genesis 17:19

Genesis 17: 7 makes any and all covenants everlasting that are a part of the Abrahamic Covenant including the Seed Covenant, the Canaan Land Covenant, The Davidic Covenant, and the New Covenant. For all you Islamic devils out there, we unequivocally restate that the covenant was with Isaac and NOT Ishmael.

We will expand upon each of these covenants in greater detail below. We must understand these

covenants if we are to rightly understand God's relationship to Israel and God's relationship to the Church. Israel is the wife of God. Israel as the wife of God is strictly Jewish. The Church is the bride of Christ. The Church is both a Jewish and a Gentile Bride. The Church is pictured in the book of Ruth with Boaz, the Jew, having a Gentile Bride, Ruth.

IS THE ABRAHAMIC COVENANT STILL IN FORCE?

How you interpret Bible prophecy will depend on how you view the Abrahamic Covenants. How you interpret the Abrahamic Covenants will determine how you apply the Scriptures to Israel and to the Church. Many who believe that God has set aside the covenants with Israel believe that the promises given to Israel have been transferred to the Church. They see the Church as having replaced Israel in God's plan. People that believe this way are called Replacement Theologians. The question is: Are God's covenants with Israel still in force?

There are at least six covenants that God has established in the Bible that are still in effect including the Noahic Covenant, the Mosaic Covenant, the Seed Covenant, the Canaan Land Covenant, the Davidic Covenant, and the New Covenant. The Abrahamic Covenant is composed of the Seed Covenant, the Canaan Land Covenant, the Davidic Covenant, and the New Covenant. To decide whether the covenants still apply to Israel we must answer two questions: (1) Were the covenants unconditional and (2) Were the covenants stated by God to be everlasting or forever?.

An unconditional covenant is based upon the "I will" of God. In an unconditional covenant, the fulfillment of the covenant is not conditioned upon the obedience of man. The conditional covenant is based upon a "If man will, God will" scenario. Of the six covenants included above, the only conditional covenant was the Mosaic Covenant. For the Christian, the Mosaic Covenant has been set aside in the Lord Jesus Christ. Although the Mosaic Covenant was specifically given to Israel, its contents is written into the conscious of all of mankind. The Mosaic Covenant is the standard of condemnation to all mankind. The Noahic Covenant is an unconditional covenant that does not require the participation of mankind. The Noahic Covenant was God's unconditional, everlasting covenant with all of mankind that He would never entirely flood the earth again. The Abrahamic Covenant is an unconditional covenant that God made with Abraham. The covenant is unconditional because Abraham can do nothing to ensure or hinder its fulfillment. However, the covenant could not come into force until Abraham believed God and left Ur of the Chaldees. By faith, Abraham became a partaker of the covenant. The covenant of salvation (part of the Seed Covenant) is also an everlasting, unconditional covenant. The salvation covenant cannot come into effect for men or women until they believe God. By faith, Christians become partakers of the covenant. Salvation in the Lord Jesus Christ is THE standard of redemption for all of mankind. Every covenant included in the Abrahamic Covenant is unconditional because the fulfillment of these covenants depend solely upon the faithfulness of God. There is no action, or lack thereof, by mankind that can make void the

covenant(s). However, continued participation in the blessings of these covenants is based upon Israel's obedience to the Mosaic Covenant.

Now, what about the question of whether these covenants are everlasting? If the covenants are described as everlasting by God in the Bible, that means that they will continue forever. If that is not so, then there are many assumptions that we could make including: (1) God did not know what the word everlasting meant; (2) God confused the Church and Israel; (3) God did not know the future; (4) God was deceived; (5) God lied to us; (6) God did not know what Israel was going to do. How outrageous does all that sound? The list could go on and on, but I believe the point has been made. God knew exactly what Israel was going to do and yet God called these covenants everlasting. The following Scriptures apply to the everlasting nature of the different covenants contained within the Abrahamic Covenant:

Genesis 13:15 (Canaan Land Covenant)

¹⁵ For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever.

Genesis 17:7 (Abrahamic Covenant)

⁷ And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee.

Genesis 17:8 (Canaan Land Covenant)

⁸ And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their God.

Genesis 17:13 (Circumcision as the seal of the Covenant)

¹³ He that is born in thy house, and he that is bought with thy money, must needs be circumcised: and my covenant shall be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant.

Genesis 48:4 (Seed and Canaan Land Covenant)

⁴ And said unto me, Behold, I will make thee fruitful, and multiply thee, and I will make of thee a multitude of people; and will give this land to thy seed after thee *for* an everlasting possession.

Deuteronomy 4:31 (All Abrahamic Covenants)

³¹ (For the LORD thy God *is* a merciful God;) he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them.

Judges 2:1 (Canaan Land Covenant)

¹ And an angel of the LORD came up from Gilgal to Bochim, and said, I made you to go up out of Egypt, and have brought you unto the land which I sware unto your fathers; and I said, I will never break my covenant with you.

2 Samuel 7:13 (Davidic Covenant)

¹³ He shall build an house for my name, and I will stablish the throne of his kingdom for ever.

2 Samuel 7:16 (Davidic Covenant)

¹⁶ And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established for ever.

2 Samuel 7:24 (Seed Covenant)

²⁴ For thou hast confirmed to thyself thy people Israel *to be* a people unto thee for ever: and thou, LORD, art become their God.

2 Samuel 23:5 (Davidic Covenant)

⁵ Although my house *be* not so with God; yet he hath made with me an everlasting covenant, ordered in all *things*, and sure: for *this is* all my salvation, and all *my* desire, although he make *it* not to grow.

1 Kings 2:45 (Davidic Covenant)

⁴⁵ And king Solomon *shall be* blessed, and the throne of David shall be established before the LORD for ever.

1 Kings 9:5 (Davidic Covenant taken from Solomon, but still in force)

⁵ Then I will establish the throne of thy kingdom upon Israel for ever, as I promised to David thy father, saying, There shall not fail thee a man upon the throne of Israel.

1 Chronicles 16:15-18 (Davidic Covenant taken from Solomon, but still in force)

¹⁵ Be ye mindful always of his covenant; the word *which* he commanded to a thousand generations; ¹⁶ Even of the covenant which he made with Abraham, and of his oath unto Isaac; ¹⁷ And hath confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting covenant, ¹⁸ Saying, Unto thee will I give the land of Canaan, the lot of your inheritance;

1 Chronicles 17:12-14 (Davidic Covenant)

¹² He shall build me an house, and I will stablish his throne for ever. ¹³ I will be his father, and he shall be my son: and I will not take my mercy away from him, as I took *it* from *him* that was before thee: ¹⁴ But I will settle him in mine house and in my kingdom for ever: and his throne shall be established for evermore.

1 Chronicles 28:2-7 (Davidic Covenant taken from Solomon, but still in force)

²Then David the king stood up upon his feet, and said, Hear me, my brethren, and my people: *As for me*, I *had* in mine heart to build an house of rest for the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and for the footstool of our God, and had made ready for the building: ³ But God said unto me, Thou shalt not build an house for my name, because thou *hast been* a man of war, and hast shed blood. ⁴ Howbeit the LORD God of Israel chose me before all the house of my father to be king over Israel for ever: for he hath chosen Judah *to be* the ruler; and of the house of Judah, the house of my father; and among the sons of my father he liked me to make *me* king over all Israel: ⁵ And of all my sons, (for the LORD hath given me many sons,) he hath chosen Solomon my son to sit upon the throne of the kingdom of the LORD over Israel. ⁶ And he said unto me, Solomon thy son, he shall build my house and my courts: for I have chosen him *to be* my son, and I will be his father. ⁷ Moreover I will establish his kingdom for ever, if he be constant to do my commandments and my judgments, as at this day.

2 Chronicles 7:18 (Davidic Covenant)

¹⁸Then will I stablish the throne of thy kingdom, according as I have covenanted with David thy father, saying, There shall not fail thee a man *to be* ruler in Israel.

2 Chronicles 13:5 (Davidic Covenant)

⁵Ought ye not to know that the LORD God of Israel gave the kingdom over Israel to

David for ever, even to him and to his sons by a covenant of salt?

2 Chronicles 20:7 (Canaan Land Covenant)

⁷ Art not thou our God, who didst drive out the inhabitants of this land before thy people Israel, and gavest it to the seed of Abraham thy friend for ever?

Psalm 89:3-4 (Seed and Davidic Covenant)

³ I have made a covenant with my chosen, I have sworn unto David my servant, ⁴ Thy seed will I establish for ever, and build up thy throne to all generations. Selah.

Psalm 89:28-36 (**Seed and Davidic Covenant**)²⁸ My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and my covenant shall stand fast with him. ²⁹ His seed also will I make *to endure* for ever, and his throne as the days of heaven. ³⁰ If his children forsake my law, and walk not in my judgments; ³¹ If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments; ³² Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes. ³³ Nevertheless my lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail. ³⁴ My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. ³⁵ Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie unto David. ³⁶ His seed shall endure for ever, and his throne as the sun before me.

Psalm 105:8-11 (All of the Abrahamic Covenant)

⁸ He hath remembered his covenant for ever, the word *which* he commanded to a thousand generations. ⁹ Which *covenant* he made with Abraham, and his oath unto Isaac; ¹⁰ And confirmed the same unto Jacob for a law, *and* to Israel *for* an everlasting covenant: ¹¹ Saying, Unto thee will I give the land of Canaan, the lot of your inheritance:

Isaiah 9:6-7 (Davidic Covenant)

⁶ For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. ⁷ Of the increase of *his* government and peace *there shall be* no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Isiah 45:17 (New Covenant)

¹⁷ But Israel shall be saved in the LORD with an everlasting salvation: ye shall not be ashamed nor confounded world without end.

Isaiah 55:3 (New Covenant)

³ Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, *even* the sure mercies of David.

Isaiah 60:21 (Canaan Land Covenant)

²¹ Thy people also *shall be* all righteous: they shall inherit the land for ever, the branch of my planting, the work of my hands, that I may be glorified.

Isaiah 61:8 (New Covenant)

⁸ For I the LORD love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.

Jeremiah 25:4-5 (Canaan Land Covenant)

⁴ And the LORD hath sent unto you all his servants the prophets, rising early and sending *them*; but ye have not hearkened, nor inclined your ear to hear. ⁵ They said, Turn ye again now every one from his evil way, and from the evil of your doings, and dwell in the land that the LORD hath given unto you and to your fathers for ever and ever:

Jeremiah 31:31-40 (Seed, New, and Canaan Land Covenants)

³¹ Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah: ³² Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day *that* I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD: ³³ But this *shall be* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people. ³⁴ And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more. ³⁵ Thus saith the LORD, which giveth the sun for a light by day, *and* the ordinances of the moon and of the stars for a light by night, which divideth the sea when the waves thereof roar: The LORD of hosts *is* his name: ³⁶ If

those ordinances depart from before me, saith the LORD, *then* the seed of Israel also shall cease from being a nation before me for ever. ³⁷ Thus saith the LORD; If heaven above can be measured, and the foundations of the earth searched out beneath, I will also cast off all the seed of Israel for all that they have done, saith the LORD. ³⁸ Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that the city shall be built to the LORD from the tower of Hananeel unto the gate of the corner. ³⁹ And the measuring line shall yet go forth over against it upon the hill Gareb, and shall compass about to Goath. ⁴⁰ And the whole valley of the dead bodies, and of the ashes, and all the fields unto the brook of Kidron, unto the corner of the horse gate toward the east, *shall be* holy unto the LORD; it shall not be plucked up, nor thrown down any more for ever.

Jeremiah 32:37-41 (New Covenant)

³⁷ Behold, I will gather them out of all countries, whither I have driven them in mine anger, and in my fury, and in great wrath; and I will bring them again unto this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely: ³⁸ And they shall be my people, and I will be their God: ³⁹ And I will give them one heart, and one way, that they may fear me for ever, for the good of them, and of their children after them: ⁴⁰ And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; but I will put my fear in their hearts, that they shall not depart from me. ⁴¹ Yea, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will plant them in this land assuredly with my whole heart and with my whole soul.

Jeremiah 33:20-26 (Seed and Davidic Covenants)

²⁰ Thus saith the LORD; If ye can break my covenant of the day, and my covenant of the night, and that there should not be day and night in their season; ²¹ *Then* may also my covenant be broken with David my servant, that he should not have a son to reign upon his throne; and with the Levites the priests, my ministers. ²² As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, neither the sand of the sea measured: so will I multiply the seed of David my servant, and the Levites that minister unto me. ²³ Moreover the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah, saying, ²⁴ Considerest thou not what this people have spoken, saying, The two families which the LORD hath chosen, he hath even cast them off? thus they have despised my people, that they should be no more a nation before them. ²⁵ Thus saith the LORD; If my covenant *be* not with day and night, *and if* I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth; ²⁶ Then will I cast away the seed of Jacob, and David my servant, so that I will not take *any* of his seed *to be* rulers over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: for I will cause their captivity to return, and have mercy on them.

Ezekiel 16:60-63 (New Covenant)⁶⁰ Nevertheless I will remember my covenant with

thee in the days of thy youth, and I will establish unto thee an everlasting covenant. ⁶¹ Then thou shalt remember thy ways, and be ashamed, when thou shalt receive thy sisters, thine elder and thy younger: and I will give them unto thee for daughters, but not by thy covenant. ⁶² And I will establish my covenant with thee; and thou shalt know that I *am* the LORD: ⁶³ That thou mayest remember, and be confounded, and never open thy mouth any more because of thy shame, when I am pacified toward thee for all that thou hast done, saith the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 37:15-28 (Seed, New, and Davidic Covenants)

¹⁵ The word of the LORD came again unto me, saying, ¹⁶ Moreover, thou son of man, take thee one stick, and write upon it, For Judah, and for the children of Israel his companions: then take another stick, and write upon it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and for all the house of Israel his companions: ¹⁷ And join them one to another into one stick; and they shall become one in thine hand. 18 And when the children of thy people shall speak unto thee, saying, Wilt thou not shew us what thou meanest by these? ¹⁹ Say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will take the stick of Joseph, which is in the hand of Ephraim, and the tribes of Israel his fellows, and will put them with him, even with the stick of Judah, and make them one stick, and they shall be one in mine hand. ²⁰ And the sticks whereon thou writest shall be in thine hand before their eyes. ²¹ And say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will take the children of Israel from among the heathen, whither they be gone, and will gather them on every side, and bring them into their own land: ²² And I will make them one nation in the land upon the mountains of Israel; and one king shall be king to them all: and they shall be no more two nations, neither shall they be divided into two kingdoms any more at all: ²³ Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save them out of all their dwellingplaces, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: so shall they be my people, and I will be their God. ²⁴ And David my servant *shall be* king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them. ²⁵ And they shall dwell in the land that I have given unto Jacob my servant, wherein your fathers have dwelt; and they shall dwell therein, even they, and their children, and their children's children for ever; and my servant David shall be their prince for ever. ²⁶ Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore. ²⁷My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people. ²⁸ And the heathen shall know that I the LORD do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore.

Is there any question about the everlasting nature of these covenants? We have cited 33groups of Old Testament Scriptures that prove the everlasting nature of each and every covenant under the Abrahamic Covenant. What does the word everlasting mean? The last I checked it meant never ending. Every one of these covenants is said to apply to Abraham and his seed through Isaac. The Scriptures have presented verse stacked upon verse that state that these covenants apply to Israel and not the Church. So there is a seed (spiritual and physical), a land (Canaan), a throne (David's), and an everlasting relationship (the New Covenant) promised to Israel and its people.

THE NEW COVENANT

The book of Hebrews is obviously written to Jewish Christians. The New Covenant is mentioned quite frequently in the book of Hebrews. In fact, the book of Hebrews sets up a contrast between the Old Covenant and the New Covenant. It is a contrast between a mortal priesthood and the immortal priesthood of the Lord Jesus Christ. It is a contrast between works and grace. It is a contrast between the blood of the sacrifices and the Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. The Old Covenant is a covenant of condemnation to eternal death. The New Covenant is a covenant of salvation unto eternal life. The New Covenant is both a national covenant and an individual covenant. The New Covenant is a promise of resurrection from the grave of nations. In almost every Scripture where the New Covenant is described, it is connected to a gathering out of the nations. For a gathering out of the nations to take place, there must be a gathering into a new land. That is why the New Covenant is connected both to the national salvation of Israel and the individual salvation of Jews. That this is true is obvious from Jeremiah 31:31-40, Jeremiah 32:37-41, Ezekiel 11:17-20, and Ezekiel 36:24-28. The whole plan comes together in Ezekiel 37:15-28 where we see a restatement of the Abrahamic Covenant. Once again the covenant is called an everlasting covenant. Hebrews 8:8-12 and Hebrews 10:16-17 are a New Testament statement to the continuing nature of the covenant promised in the Scriptures from Jeremiah 31:31-34. These Scriptures state:

Hebrews 8:8-12

⁸ For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: ⁹ Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord. ¹⁰ For this *is* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people: ¹¹ And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest. ¹² For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and

their iniquities will I remember no more.

Hebrews 10:16-17

¹⁶ This *is* the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; ¹⁷ And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.

Hebrews 12:23-24 and Hebrews 13:20 once again testify to the everlasting nature of this covenant:

Hebrews 12:23-24

²³ To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect, ²⁴ And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than *that of* Abel.

Hebrews 13:20

²⁰ Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant.

That Paul expected this covenant to be a continuing covenant is obvious from Acts 26:6-7, Romans 9:4-10, Romans 11:1-2, Romans 11:26-27, Romans 15:8, Hebrews 8:8-12, Hebrews 10:16-17, Hebrews 12:23-24, and Hebrews 13:20. For the Jew, the promises of the New Covenant are also linked to the spiritual seed of the Seed Covenant.

THE SEED COVENANT AND THE GENTILES

Romans 4, Romans 11, Galatians 3, and Ephesians 2 state that the spiritual benefits under the Seed Covenant apply to the Gentiles. This means that all Gentiles who believe in the Lord Jesus Christ are the spiritual seed of Abraham. Romans 4:9-16, Romans 11:11, Galatians 3:26-29, and Ephesians 2:11-16 say:

Romans 4:9-16

⁹ Cometh this blessedness then upon the circumcision only, or upon the uncircumcision also? for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for

righteousness. ¹⁰ How was it then reckoned? when he was in circumcision, or in uncircumcision? Not in circumcision, but in uncircumcision. ¹¹ And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which *he had yet* being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also: ¹² And the father of circumcision to them who are not of the circumcision only, but who also walk in the steps of that faith of our father Abraham, which *he had* being *yet* uncircumcised. ¹³ For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, *was* not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith. ¹⁴ For if they which are of the law *be* heirs, faith is made void, and the promise made of none effect: ¹⁵ Because the law worketh wrath: for where no law is, *there is* no transgression. ¹⁶ Therefore *it is* of faith, that *it might be* by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

Romans 11:11 ¹¹I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: but *rather* through their fall salvation *is come* unto the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy.

Galatians 3:26-29

²⁶ For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. ²⁷ For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. ²⁸ There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus. ²⁹ And if ye *be* Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Ephesians 2:11-16

11 Wherefore remember, that ye *being* in time past Gentiles in the flesh, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands; 12 That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world: 13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ. 14 For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition *between us*; 15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, *even* the law of commandments *contained* in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, *so* making peace; 16 And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

The phrase "the promise(s)" is another Bible term that refers to the Abrahamic Covenants. Romans 4:13 says that the promises came to the Gentiles (uncircumcision) through the righteousness of faith. Romans 11:11 says that salvation came to the Gentiles through the fall of the Jews. Romans 11 is clear that the Jews have not been set aside permanently. Theirs is a **TEMPORARY** blindness until the fulness of the Gentiles be brought in. Galatians 3:28 says that the promises of the Seed Covenant apply to both the Jew and the Greek (Gentile). Ephesians 2:11-16 makes it clear that both the Jew and the Gentiles are both heirs to the covenants of promise. The Lord Jesus Christ Himself has extended the invitation to become partakers in the Covenant to all nations through what is commonly called "The Great Commission (Commandment)". Matthew 28:19-20 says:

Matthew 28:19-20

¹⁹ Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: ²⁰ Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, *even* unto the end of the world. Amen.

THE CANAAN LAND COVENANT

For the worldly, apostate church of today the most controversial of the Abrahamic Covenants is the Canaan Land Covenant. We have already proved that everyone of the Abrahamic Covenants are still in effect. Today, if you are going to stand for the right of Israel to the Promised Land you are going to have to be prepared for a lot of heat from today's apostate, effeminate church that will not stand for anything, but will fall for every false doctrine that blows in off the Satanic seas of unbelief and anti-Semitism. In today's world, it will take convictions and not preferences to stand for Israel. Any church that will not stand for Israel cannot be in full fellowship with God. Most churches in America today are anti-Israel and pro "Palestinian". Any church that will not stand for Israel cannot receive the blessings of God and is under the curse of God. Genesis 12:3 says: "And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed". We say again that the violence perpetrated against Jews and Bible believing Christians by the Roman Catholic Church, Martin Luther and his followers, John Calvin and his followers, Ulrich Zwingli and his followers, the Anglican Church in England and America, and any other persecutor in any land is worse than the Islamic terror of today because so-called "Christians" ought to know better. The god of this world, Satan, is hell bent on the destruction of Israel, Bible believing Christians, and all Jews. The Muslims know no peace with Israel until they have destroyed the last Jew living on the face of this earth. One Muslim leader after another has stated that the battle with Israel is not about borders, but is about the very existence of Israel.

The promises concerning the Canaan Land Covenant are a major subject in the Old Testament. The promise of the land and its boundaries is the subject of Genesis 12:7, Genesis 13:15, Genesis 15:18, Genesis 17:8, Genesis 24:7, Genesis 26:4, Exodus 23:27-31, Exodus 32:13, Numbers 34:1-12, Deuteronomy 1:6-8, Deuteronomy 11:22-24, Joshua 1:2-4, 1 Kings 4:21, 2 Chronicles 9:26, Psalm 105:6-11, Isaiah 60:21, and Ezekiel 37:25. Genesis 17:8 says that the land has been given for an everlasting possession. Exodus 32:13 states that Israel shall inherit the land for ever. Psalm 105 verses 10 and 11 declare the covenant to be everlasting. Isaiah 60:21 states that they shall inherit the land forever. Jeremiah 25:5 states that the land was given to Israel for ever and ever. Jeremiah 32:40-41 says that God will make an everlasting covenant with them and plant them in the land. Ezekiel 37:25 declares that the children of Israel will dwell in the land forever. Ezekiel 11:17, Ezekiel 20:42, and Ezekiel 34:13 speak of a time when God will gather the children of Israel into their own land. Genesis 15:18 roughly sets the boundaries for this land called the Promised Land.

While Genesis 15:18 gives the general outline for the boundaries for the Promised Land, Exodus 23:27-31, Numbers 34:1-12, Deuteronomy 1:6-8, Deuteronomy 11:22-24, and Joshua 1:2-4 give some fairly specific details on the boundaries. These Scriptures state:

Genesis 15:18

¹⁸ In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates:

Exodus 23:27-31

²⁷ I will send my fear before thee, and will destroy all the people to whom thou shalt come, and I will make all thine enemies turn their backs unto thee. ²⁸ And I will send hornets before thee, which shall drive out the Hivite, the Canaanite, and the Hittite, from before thee. ²⁹ I will not drive them out from before thee in one year; lest the land become desolate, and the beast of the field multiply against thee. ³⁰ By little and little I will drive them out from before thee, until thou be increased, and inherit the land. ³¹ And I will set thy bounds from the Red sea even unto the sea of the Philistines, and from the desert unto the river: for I will deliver the inhabitants of the land into your hand; and thou shalt drive them out before thee.

Numbers 34:1-12

¹ And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, ² Command the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye come into the land of Canaan; (this *is* the land that shall fall unto you for an inheritance, *even* the land of Canaan with the coasts thereof:) ³ Then your south quarter shall be from the wilderness of Zin along by the coast of Edom, and

your south border shall be the outmost coast of the salt sea eastward: 4 And your border shall turn from the south to the ascent of Akrabbim, and pass on to Zin: and the going forth thereof shall be from the south to Kadeshbarnea, and shall go on to Hazaraddar, and pass on to Azmon: 5 And the border shall fetch a compass from Azmon unto the river of Egypt, and the goings out of it shall be at the sea. ⁶ And as for the western border, ye shall even have the great sea for a border: this shall be your west border. ⁷ And this shall be your north border: from the great sea ye shall point out for you mount Hor: 8 From mount Hor ye shall point out *your border* unto the entrance of Hamath; and the goings forth of the border shall be to Zedad: 9 And the border shall go on to Ziphron, and the goings out of it shall be at Hazarenan: this shall be your north border. ¹⁰ And ye shall point out your east border from Hazarenan to Shepham: 11 And the coast shall go down from Shepham to Riblah, on the east side of Ain; and the border shall descend, and shall reach unto the side of the sea of Chinnereth eastward: ¹² And the border shall go down to Jordan, and the goings out of it shall be at the salt sea: this shall be your land with the coasts thereof round about.

Deuteronomy 1:6-8

⁶ The LORD our God spake unto us in Horeb, saying, Ye have dwelt long enough in this mount: ⁷ Turn you, and take your journey, and go to the mount of the Amorites, and unto all *the places* nigh thereunto, in the plain, in the hills, and in the vale, and in the south, and by the sea side, to the land of the Canaanites, and unto Lebanon, unto the great river, the river Euphrates. ⁸ Behold, I have set the land before you: go in and possess the land which the LORD sware unto your fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give unto them and to their seed after them.

Deuteronomy 11:22-24 ²² For if ye shall diligently keep all these commandments which I command you, to do them, to love the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, and to cleave unto him; ²³ Then will the LORD drive out all these nations from before you, and ye shall possess greater nations and mightier than yourselves. ²⁴ Every place whereon the soles of your feet shall tread shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the river Euphrates, even unto the uttermost sea shall your coast be.

Joshua 1:2-4

²Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, *even* to the children of Israel. ³ Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses. ⁴ From the wilderness and this Lebanon even unto the great river, the

river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and unto the great sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your coast.

There are a lot of details in these Scriptures. A major problem with them is exactly pinpointing them on a modern map. A problem with determining the locations is that several of the cities called out in these Scriptures have been destroyed. However, there is enough information given to get a good idea of what the boundaries ARE. The western border is the Mediterranean Sea. The northern border is on a line that runs roughly due east from a little north of Tripoli, Lebanon to intersect the Euphrates River just north of Tikrik, Iraq. The southern border would run on a line drawn from the tip of the Red Sea to intersect the River of Egypt at a right angle. The eastern border would run roughly on a line drawn from the tip of the Red Sea in the southwest to the Euphrates River in the northeast. These boundaries would include much of Lebanon, Jordan, portions of Syria including Damascus, and some of Iraq. The majority of people argue that this promise was fulfilled to Israel during the reign of Solomon. They say that all the land was occupied and ruled by Solomon. While we agree that Israel occupied most of the Promised Land under Solomon, we do not believe that Israel occupied the land to the fullest extent guaranteed under the covenant. But that really is not the point. We could argue from here to eternity about what the borders actually were and whether Israel has actually occupied the territory specified in the Canaan Land Covenant. The one thing that we cannot argue about is the timeless nature of the covenant.

God declares the covenant to be everlasting. If the covenant is everlasting, it makes not one whit of difference whether Israel at one time occupied all of the land promised to them. The question is: Has Israel occupied that land eternally (that is what everlasting means)? The answer to that question is obvious to anyone that is not willfully blind. If you had to temporarily move to a foreign land and some foreign squatter moved into your house while you were gone, would that house still be yours when you returned even though you had not occupied it for many years? Of course, it would still be yours. The so-called "Palestinians" are Satan's squatters. The land does not belong to the "Palestinians", the Lebanese, the Syrians, or the Iraqis. Just as there was resistence when the children of Israel first came into the Promised Land (Canaan) the first time, there has been much resistence to the return of Israel to the land that God has promised them for an everlasting possession.

ARE THE COVENANTS MADE NULL AND VOID BECAUSE OF ISRAEL'S DISOBEDIENCE?

Many argue that the covenants have been made null and void because of Israel's disobedience. That is not true for several reasons. We have already proved that God has stated that the covenants are

both (1) everlasting, and (2) unconditional. God would not have called the covenants everlasting if their fulfillment were based upon the obedience or faithfulness of man. Even the best of mankind is disobedient and unfaithful to God. The guarantee for the fulfillment of the covenants was not based upon the works of man, but rather the work and faithfulness of God. The fact that God would not allow Abraham to participate in the ceremony that sealed the covenant means that the covenant would not be conditioned on the actions or obedience of Abraham or his seed. In instance after instance we can document the disobedience of the children of Israel in the books of Exodus, Numbers, Deuteronomy, Joshua, Judges, 1 Samuel, 2 Samuel, 1 Kings, 2 Kings, 1 Chronicles, 2 Chronicles, and the prophets. They were a wicked people just like we are. Yet, God continues to state that the covenants are everlasting in the books of the law, the historical books, the Psalms, and in the prophets. Even in the midst of wholesale apostasy and idolatry, God time and again reaffirms the covenants through the prophets Isaiah, Jeremiah, and Ezekiel. So, are the covenants made null and void by disobedience? Psalm 89:30-34 clearly states:

³⁰ If his children forsake my law, and walk not in my judgments; ³¹ If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments; ³² Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes. ³³ Nevertheless my lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail. ³⁴ My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips.

Did you hear that? God says that in spite of their disobedience He will not break His covenant God again plainly states in Romans 11:1-2, 26-27:

¹ I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, *of* the tribe of Benjamin. ²God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying, ²⁶ And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: ²⁷ For this *is* my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.

Based upon the Scriptural evidence, we would have to conclude that the covenants are absolutely everlasting and unconditional. The covenants cannot be set aside by the actions of fickle mankind. They are God's covenants.

CANAAN LAND OR PALESTINE?

Earlier we made the statement that the covenant concerning the land is wrongfully referred to by

many Bible believing Christians including Baptists as the Palestinian Covenant. Christians should never, never, ever refer to the land of Israel as Palestine. There never has been a "Palestinian" people. In the list of nations given in Genesis 15:19-21 that would be driven out of the land of Canaan for Israel to possess the land, you do not see the "Palestinians" listed simply because they never have existed. Read it for yourself. The term Palestine is a derogatory name that was given to the lands of Israel after their revolt against the Roman empire. The name was changed to Palestine by the Romans in 135 A.D. to mock and shame the Jewish people by naming the land after their ancient, extinct enemies the Philistines. The name Palestine and Palestinian is used to this day to taunt the Jewish people. You will not find the name Palestine anywhere in the Bible except in Joel 3:4. However, it is interesting that this name Palestine would occur in the context of a scripture that promises judgement and destruction upon anyone who takes it upon themselves to divide the land that God has promised to His chosen people the Jews. God said in Joel 3:2:

I will also gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them there for my people and for my heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations, and parted my land.

The so-called "Palestinians" are the leading advocates of land for "peace" deals that are nothing more than a pretext to buy more time for the destruction of Israel and the murder of innocent women and children. Time after time so-called peace proposals have called for Israel to give up more and more land for a false peace. God has said that this is not his will and will bring judgment upon those who participate in it. (Even so, come Lord Jesus...PLEASE). Although God has given Israel title deed to the land, He refers to it as "my land" in Joel 3:2.

The name Palestina is used in Exodus 15:14, Isaiah 14:29, and Isaiah 14:31. The Bible names that are used to describe the Jewish homeland are Israel, Judaea, Samaria, Galilee, the promised land, or Canaan. There is no such Biblical land as Palestine. There never has been a Palestinian people. The "Palestinians" are nothing but nomadic political pawns of Satanic Islamic political regimes used by Satan and his Islamic brothers to constantly stir up strife and hatred of the Jewish people. These wicked peoples and regimes are Satan's pawns and persecutors that prefigure the events of Revelation 12. In the light of Genesis 12:3, Joel 3:2, and Matthew 25:31-46 we need to be very careful about how we treat Israel. Matthew 25:31-46 is a restatement by the Lord Jesus Christ of the blessings and curses tied to the Abrahamic Covenant given to Abram (Abraham) in Genesis 12:3. Matthew 25:31-46 says:

³¹ When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: ³² And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth *his* sheep from the goats: ³³ And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on

the left. ³⁴ Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: ³⁵ For I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in: ³⁶ Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me. ³⁷ Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink? 38 When saw we thee a stranger, and took thee in? or naked, and clothed thee? ³⁹ Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee? ⁴⁰ And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me. 41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels: 42 For I was an hungred, and ye gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and ve gave me no drink: 43 I was a stranger, and ve took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not. 44 Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee? ⁴⁵ Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these, ye did it not to me. 46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.

The brethren of the Lord Jesus Christ are the Jewish people.

We have been told the LIE time and again that Islam is a religion of peace, but nothing could be further from the truth. Many of our distinguished and deceived religious and political leaders have stated that the God of Christianity and Judaism is the god of Islam. Nothing could be further from the truth. The god of Islam does not have a son. The God of Christianity and Judaism loves Israel. The god of Islam hates Jews and Christians. The god of Islam and the god of Roman Catholicism converts with a bloody sword. The God of the Bible converts with the sword of the spirit which is the Word of God. It is a spiritual battle between God (Jehovah of the Bible) and the Devil. The objective of the Satanically controlled Arabs, Turks, Iranians (Persians), Ethiopians, Egyptians, Syrians, Libyans, Russians, and etcetera is the destruction of Israel and the murder of the Jewish people. Pardon the bad English, but it ain't gonna happen. We should be wary of the recent love affair between Iran, Turkey, Syria, and the so called "Palestinians". Take a look also at the former vassal states of southern Russia that have embraced Islam. They are also a part of the forces that will attack Israel in Ezekiel 38-39. Take a look at the recent love affair between Turkmenistan and Iran. What is the quasi official religion of Russia? It is Eastern Orthodoxy as practiced by the Russian Orthodox Church. The iconic birds of Eastern Orthodoxy are preparing to make their flight back to Rome. In fact, most of the world's Protestants have been cooing up to the vulture of Roman Catholicism. Little wonder when Roman Catholicism is the cage of every unclean and hateful bird and the habitation of devils (Revelation 18:2). Consider this also: the 1994 Roman Catholic Catechism refers to the Muslims as brothers of Roman Catholics. That is rightfully so since they both worship Baal and the Queen of Heaven. Unlike Bible believing Christians, Muslims and Roman Catholics do not worship the God of the Bible, but rather the god of this world who is none other than the dragon, that old serpent, which is the devil, and Satan. The Islamic coalition of Ezekiel 38-39 that will be destroyed on the mountains of Israel is an anti-Semitic Satanic horde. The one-world coalition that will meet its doom at Armageddon is an anti-Semitic Satanic horde. The common serpentine trait that slithers through them all is that they all hate Jews and Bible believing Christians. If you want a more in depth history of the persecution of Jews and Bible believing Christians by Roman Catholicism, we suggest the book "A Woman Rides The Beast" by Dave Hunt. If you would like to do even further research into the "Palestinian" issue, we would encourage to get the book "From Time Immemorial, The Origins Of The Arab-Jewish Conflict Over Palestine" by Joan

Peters. It may be the most throughly researched secular book available on this issue. When this lady set out to research this book, she started out with the idea that the so-called "Palestinians" were the victims in this conflict. So, her starting premise was a pro "Palestinian" position. I quote a statement she made about herself in the very first sentences of chapter 1 of her book:

"It was not until this book was well underway that I reluctantly confronted the historical factors underlying the "Palestinian problem." The book was originally meant to be solely an investigation of the current plight of the "Arab refugees," as that subject was then generally known...From that starting point, I came to learn that the Arabs weren't the only unfortunates who fled from their homes at the time of the Arab-Israeli War of Independence. Because I'd assumed that Arab refugees from Israel were the "Middle East refugees," I was startled to find that, also around 1948, whole Jewish populations from numerous Arab countries had been forced to flee as refugees to Israel and elsewhere in the world". (pages 3-4)

In her book, she documents the chicanery and duplicity of the United States' State Department and the British Foreign Office in dealing with the persecution and murder of Jews by all of the governments in the Middle East. The United States' State Department and most American diplomats have always been predominantly anti-Israel.
